Musical Theatre Camp Curriculum Details

Students enrolled in **The Showtime Summer Performing Arts Program Musical Theatre Camp** will be grouped by age, experience and ability. Each camper will remain with his or her group and will rotate between acting, voice/music and dance class. **After lunch, all campers will work together in rehearsal for the camp performance.**

Acting: Classes include Audition Technique, Improvisation, Theater Games, Scene Study, Character Analysis, and more. Performance skills are developed through creative dramatics utilizing theatre games, developing communication skills, self-confidence and poise.

Music: Learn the proper way to use your voice and what material is best for you in our vocal technique and coaching class. Plus exciting classes in Musical Theatre study! Additionally, each student will enjoy spending time in our recording studio recording their very own CD's!

Dance: Jazz, Hip-Hop, and Musical Theatre dance are offered during each four week session. Instruction is for all levels and age groups. Students will work on technique and performance styling so that they can utilize their dance skills in our musical production at the end of each four week session.

Each four week session ends with a full length musical performance in our 80 seat professional theater.

The Wizard of Oz (ages 5-10)

June 7–July 2, 2010 Little Dorothy Gale of Kansas, like so many girls her age, dreams of what lies over the rainbow. One day a twister hits her farm and carries her away over the rainbow to another world. Come join Dorothy, the Scarecrow, the Tin Man, the Cowardly Lion and Toto as they travel the universe of Dorothy's imagination.

LITTLE SHOP OF HORRORS (ages 11&up)

June 7–July 2, 2010 A down-and out skid row floral assistant becomes an overnight sensation when he discovers an exotic plant with a mysterious craving for fresh blood. Soon "Audrey II" grows into an ill-tempered, foul-mouthed, R&B-singing carnivore who offers him fame and fortune in exchange for feeding its growing appetite, finally revealing itself to be an alien creature poised for global domination!

JOSEPH and the AMAZING TECHNICOLOR DREAMCOAT (all Ages)

July 5–July 30, 2010 Joseph, his father's favorite son, is a boy blessed with prophetic dreams. When he is sold into slavery by his jealous brothers and taken to Egypt, Joseph endures a series of adventures in which his spirit and humanity are continually challenged. When news of Joseph's gift to interpret dreams reaches the Pharaoh (wryly and riotously depicted as Elvis), Joseph is well on his way to becoming second in command. Eventually his brothers, having suffered greatly, unknowingly find themselves groveling at the feet of the brother they betrayed but no longer recognize. After testing their integrity, Joseph reveals himself leading to a heartfelt reconciliation of the sons of Israel. Set to an engaging cornucopia of musical styles, from country-western and calypso to bubble-gum pop and rock 'n' roll.

Broadway Workshop Curriculum Details Students enrolled in **The Showtime Summer Performing Arts Broadway Workshop** will spend each week learning choreography, vocals, and scene work from the Broadway Hits **The Lion King** and **Annie**. Campers will be grouped by age, experience and ability and will rotate between dance and choreography class, and voice/music. Each day after lunch, all campers will work together on the main stage. On the last day of the week campers will perform a mini show in a revue style for family and friends!

This lunch will be offered at 12pm in buffet style and your child will be able to choose any or all of the foods offered each day. The cost is \$7 per day. **The lunch program must be reserved and paid for in full at time of registration.**

2. We will be dancing every day. Campers **must** bring their jazz shoes or jazz sneakers each day for dance class. Absolutely No Crocs or Flip-Flops! The shoes must be soft with flexible soles. We do have these shoes available for sale at the studio. Just let us know your street shoe size!!

3. We do offer a wide assortment of snacks and beverages for purchase for \$1 each. You can send money with your child each day or open a "Snack Account" from which we will deduct \$1 for each snack or beverage requested from your camper.

4. **SHOWTIME T-shirts** are available in 7 different colors. Each camper will receive one t-shirt. After that additional shirts are \$15 each. **SHOWTIME back-packs** are also available for \$15 each.

5. Before Camp (8am-9am)/After Camp (3pm-6pm) Procedure

It is recommended that you prepay for use of this service if you know that you will be utilizing it for the entire 4 week session or for certain days. The cost is \$5 per hour, as follows:

a. Morning Camp: If you have not prepaid for morning camp, your camper should be dropped off at 9am. There will be a grace period of 15 minutes (8:45-9am) for drop-off. Should you need to bring your camper anytime before 8:45am (8-8:45am), the \$5 per hour charge will apply and you must walk your child inside, sign in and pay the \$5.

b. After Camp: If you have not prepaid for after-camp, your camper should be picked up at 3pm. There will be a grace period of 15 minutes (3-3:15pm) for pick-up. Should pick-up occur anytime after 3:15pm (3:15-4pm), the \$5 per hour charge will apply and you must come inside, sign out your child and pay \$5.00 at that time. Should pick-up occur from 4-5pm, there will be an additional charge of \$5 (total \$10), from 5-6pm, there will be an additional charge of \$5 (total \$15). You must come inside to sign out your child and pay the total due for that afternoon (maximum \$15).

If you have not prepaid for this service, payment must be made on a daily basis in the form of cash at the time your child is dropped off or picked up. If you are carpooling or have made some other arrangements for release of your child such as a neighbor or caregiver, it is recommended that you either prepay, send in the amount due with the caregiver, or you must come in and pay the following morning.

6. IMPORTANT: FOR THE SAFETY OF EACH STUDENT!

Morning procedure: Each camper **MUST** be escorted into the studio and signed in by an adult.

Afternoon procedure: Each camper **MUST** be signed out by an adult to be released.
